



Parliamo Group Language Levels (based on the CEFR levels below)

Parliamo 1 is predominantly level A2

Parliamo 2 covers levels A2 - B1

Parliamo 3 covers levels B1 - B2

A1 (Breakthrough/Beginner):

Can introduce themselves and others and ask/answer simple questions about personal details.

A2 (Waystage/Elementary):

Can communicate in frequently used expressions in everyday situations, describing things around them and in simple, direct exchanges of information.

B1 (Threshold/Intermediate):

Can understand information about familiar topics and can communicate in most situations while traveling in an Italian-speaking area.

B2 (Vantage/Upper Intermediate):

Can understand the main ideas of complex texts and can interact with some fluency, communicating easily and writing clear, detailed texts.

C1 (Advanced):

Can understand a wide range of long, complex texts and express themselves with fluency and spontaneity on a wide range of topics.

C2 (Proficiency/Near-native):

Can understand virtually everything heard or read and express themselves spontaneously with native-like precision.
